



Dahlia Classroom Schedule:

A Montessori morning includes a 3-hour work cycle for three to six-year olds (Primary) at a time. A work cycle is a dedicated period of time that allows a child to work uninterrupted; they are free to choose from a variety of activities throughout the work cycle, moving purposefully and peacefully from one task to another.

Below is a peek at a typical day at your child's classroom:

7:30 - 8:00	Classroom arrangement
8:00 - 8:30	Welcoming all children
8:00 - 10:30	Work cycle (snack is available from 8:30 am until 10:30 am)
10:30 - 11:00	Circle time/Clean-up time
11:00 - 11:30	Playground time
11:30 - 11:40	Lunch preparation (washing hands)
11:40 - 12:15	Lunch
12:15 - 12:30	half day students dismissal
12:15 - 12:45	After lunch clean-up time/Story reading time
12:45 - 2:00	Nap time
1:00 - 2:15	Afternoon work-cycle for older students
2:15 - 2:30	Clean-up time/Preparation for school day students dismissal
2:30 - 2:45	School day students dismissal
2:45 - 3:15	Snack time for Full day students (After school begins)
3:15 - 6:00	Free play/Student choice of work/Music & movement
